Victor Tuzlukov



Victor Tuzlukov was born in Siberia in 1964. He started to cut gemstones around 2000 and developed his skills to highest level of perfection. He joined US Faceters Guild in 2006 and won different international competitions, including World Championship in Australia in 2010. Since that time Victor took part in many Gem Shows and personal exhibitions. His works were exposed in world-famous museums, like Louvre, Vatican Museum, Smithsonian Institution, Fersman Museum and State Historical Museum in Moscow and Natural History Museum in Los Angeles. Victor's name was included into Guinness World Records book three times (for now he is only one cutter in the world who has Guinness certificates), including the most faceted gemstone in the world with 3,600 facets.
